



What Information Do I Need When I Fill Out the FAFSA

Here's a checklist!

You should have the following information and documents with you as you fill out the 2016-17 *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA):

- Student's Social Security number
- Parent(s)' Social Security number(s)
- Student's driver's license/permit/state issued ID number (*if student has one*)
- Student's Alien Registration Number (*if student is not a U.S. citizen*)
- 2015 tax information (***if required to file***) for student and parent(s)
 - ***To complete and submit the 2016-17 FAFSA in January, use estimated tax information (i.e. 2014 tax return, 2015 W-2 information, or last paystub).***
- Records of untaxed income, such as child support received and veterans noneducation benefits, for student and parent(s)
- Information on checking and savings account balances; investments; and business and farm assets for student and parent(s)
- Student's FSA ID username/password
 - ***The student may create a FSA ID username/password by visiting fsaid.ed.gov today or while completing the 2016-17 FAFSA.***
- Parent's FSA ID username/password
 - ***A parent may create a FSA ID username/password by visiting fsaid.ed.gov today or while completing the 2016-17 FAFSA.***
